

WHAT TO PUT AND NOT PUT IN A WORM BIN


Put the following in a worm bin:

- Shredded paper products
- Fruit and vegetable trimmings
- Egg shells
- Fallen leaves
- Tea bags
- Coffee grounds and filters
- Lawn clippings and young weeds



Do not place the following in a worm bin:

- Meat products
- Dairy products
- Rocks
- Plastics
- Glass
- Metal products (e.g., aluminum cans)
- Bread products
